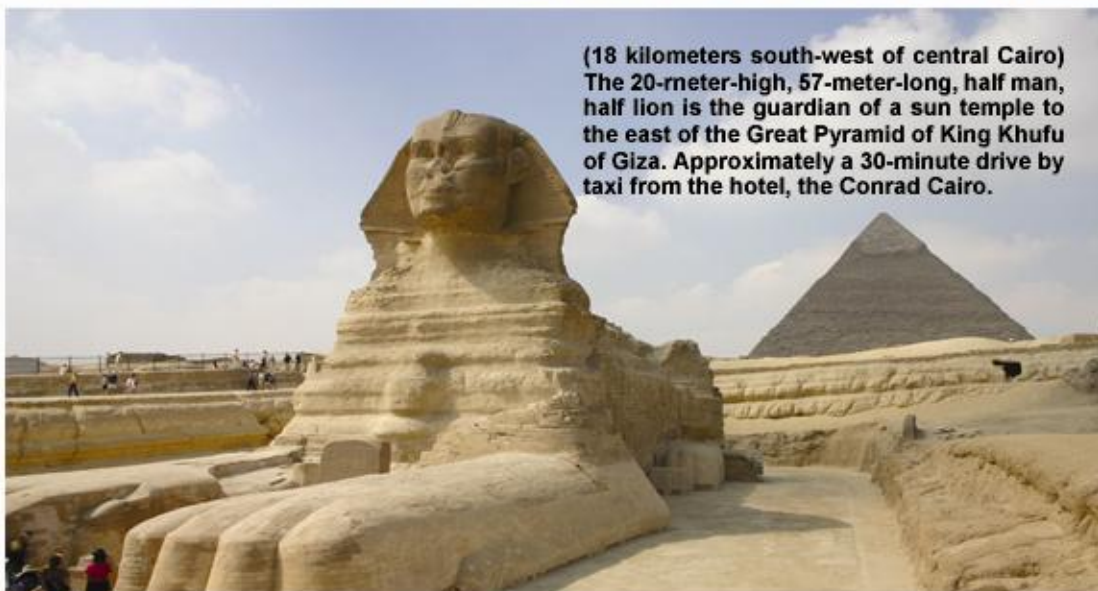
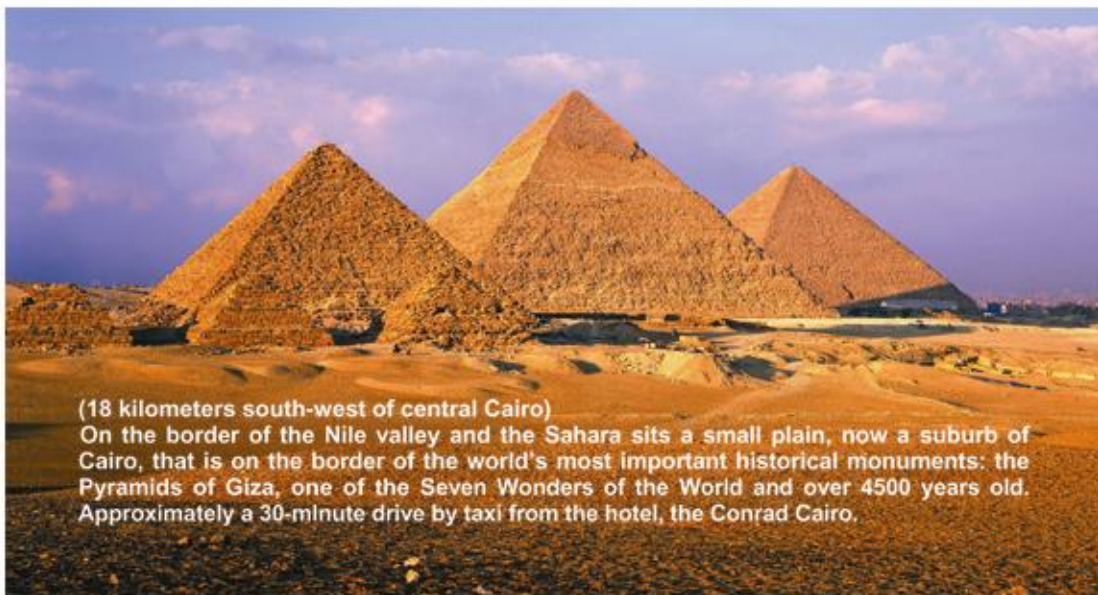
Egyptian Museum
